Alwin Holland Park or "The Glen" to locals is named after the first teacher to come to Hudson's Hope. Located in Alwin Holland Park is the cabin of Reginald "Uncle Dudley" Shaw, a pioneer of Hudson's Hope. This cabin later became home to author Bradford Angiers. With walking access to the Peace River you can spend the day fishing, painting, picnicking, taking photographs of the unique Teapot Islands, searching for that perfect river rock or simply enjoying the scenery. Alwin Holland offers twelve dry sites, outhouse, cooking boxes, fishing and hiking trails. Pets are allowed on leash. \$15.00 per night which includes an arm-full of firewood.

Cameron Lake Campground

Cameron Lake is one of the few lakes that offers good swimming during the summer months. A favorite for locals, it does not allow motorized vessels, so provides a more relaxed and tranquil atmosphere. The park offers twenty dry sites, outhouse, fire pits, swimming, hiking, fishing, playground, canoeing and kayaking. Pets are allowed on leash. \$15.00 per night which includes an arm-full of firewood.

Dinosaur Lake was created when the Peace Canyon Dam was completed in 1980 and named for the fossils of dinosaur footprints that were covered when the area was flooded. Bring your boat as you won't want to miss going upstream to the bottom of the WAC Bennett Dam to look for eagles. Keep your eyes open for the abundant wildlife on the hills and beaver and fish in the lake. Join the fun at the annual Father's Day Fishing Derby. You don't need a boat - just patience and enthusiasm. The park offers a boat launch, fifty dry sites, a water pump, outhouse, cooking boxes, fire pits, swimming, hiking trails, fishing and boating, Pets are allowed on leash. \$15.00 per night which includes an arm-full of firewood.

While you are waiting go on tour, look at the outdoor historical exhibits, stop for a snack at the Lookout Restaurant or simply enjoy the spectacular view!

HUDSON'S HOPE is a unique northern community. It has an especially rich past, from dinosaurs to fur trading and early pioneering. Its present role is strongly entrenched in power production, including BC Hydro that produces one third of provincial power from local dams to oil and gas production and coal exploration. The beauty of the town's location along the banks of the mighty Peace River draws people from around the world to come...and to stay.

Hudson's Hope is the third oldest European community in British Columbia. It is steeped in fur trading history, dating back to the late 1700's and the days of Alexander Mackenzie and the Northwest Company. The area is also one of the richest sites of fossils and dinosaur footprints in the world.

Magnificent scenery and an abundance of wildlife including bear, wolf, stone sheep, elk, moose, deer, coyotes, foxes and bald eagles offer photography and sight-seeing opportunities. The fishing in the area is excellent, with lakes and rivers full of rainbow trout, arctic grayling, white fish, lake trout, Dolly Varden trout and northern pike.

The WAC Bennett Dam is 20 minutes from Hudson's Hope and has the largest reservoir in B.C. Williston Lake Reservoir extends 200 km north from Mackenzie and 100 km east and has a surface area of 1, 773 square km.

A high emphasis is placed on the quality of life, and in it's natural setting with a multitude of recreation facilities and activities make the community of Hudson's Hope attractive not only to the residents, but to the many tourists that visit Hudson's Hope every year.
